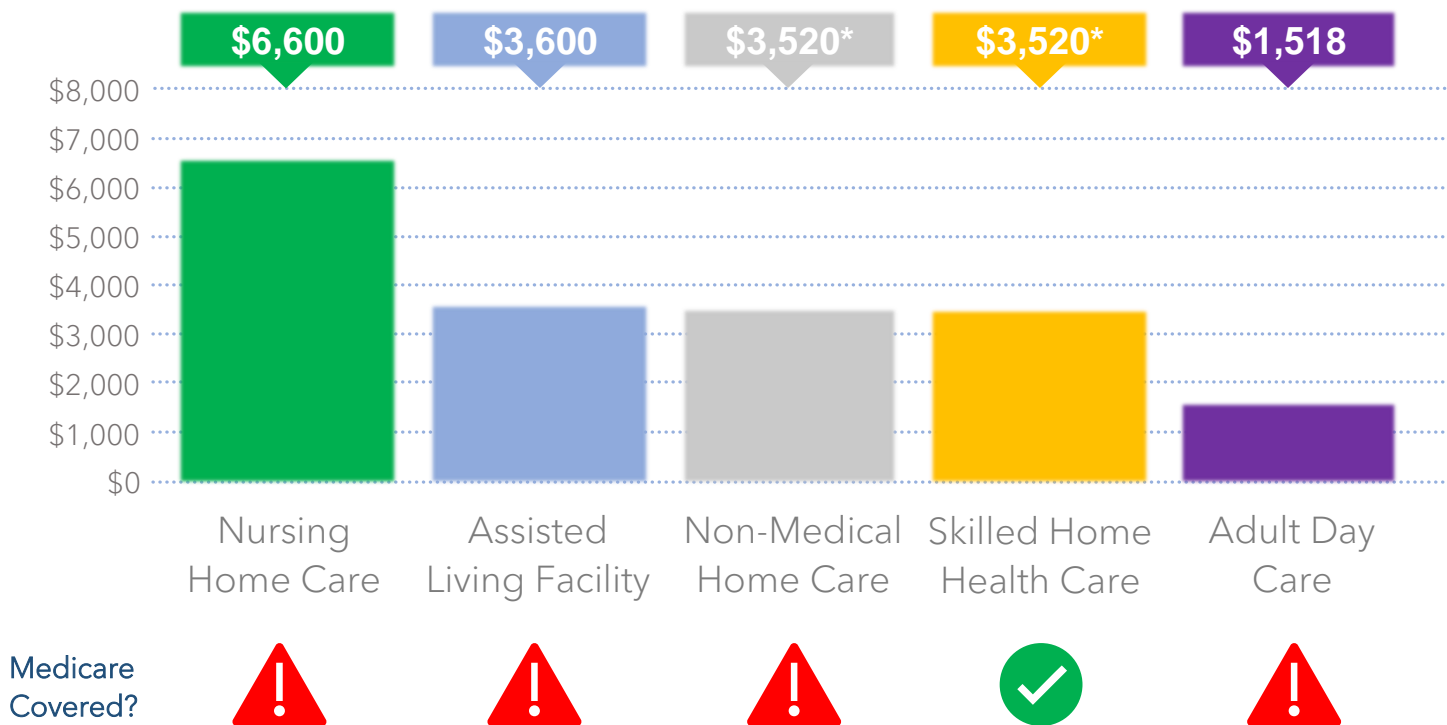


LONG-TERM CARE

What Is It, and How Much Does It Cost?

At least **69 percent** of people 65 years and older will need long-term care services at some point in their lives.¹ The cost of long-term care depends on three main factors: the kind and length of care needed, the provider chosen and the location. Here is a breakdown of some long-term care services in the United States.
